Client is responsible for: Transportation to Anchorage, Alaska. Hunting license and big game tag fees, shipping of trophies, personal hunting gear and firearms, Any expenses while in town prior to arrival at lodge or camp and after return to town no matter what date, personal liquor and gratuities are at your option. Transportation to the field will be arranged by the guide/outfitter however, charter fees round trip to lodge/camp are subject to change but at this time are as follows_____.

Services include: Guided hunt conducted with one guide per ____ client(s). Meals and lodging while at the lodge or in camps, field preparation of trophies and transportation of trophies back to Anchorage / Kodiak. Field recovery of meat will be done according to state law however the cost of shipping and or preparation of meat for clients to take home will be the client's responsibility. The registered guide-outfitter is responsible for any and all state, federal or private land use fees unless otherwise agreed to.

Weather delays and charter schedules may cause actual travel to lodge/camp or return from lodge/camp to be delayed and could shorten the time you are in the field. This is a risk involved in booking this hunt in Alaska and no compensation for shortened hunts, loss of hunting days, early success, charter delays or early departure is made as well as no extra cost is to be charged for longer stays if weather or scheduling delays keep the client in the field longer than contracted for.

In the event of cancellation by the client more than 120 days prior to the start of our hunting season, deposits shall be transferred to another hunt with us, or the deposit may be transferred to another mutually acceptable hunter secured by you. In the event of a cancellation less than 120 days prior to our season, deposit s shall be forfeited unless transferred to a mutually acceptable hunter secured by you. In the event we must cancel a hunt, due to a failure on our part, the deposit shall be returned, unless you elect to apply it to another hunt with us.

Alaska state law (AS 08.54.680 and 12 AAC 75.260) requires a big game Registered Guide-Outfitter to provide a written contract to document services being provided and items for which the client is responsible. The above items are the required items to be detailed in contract.
